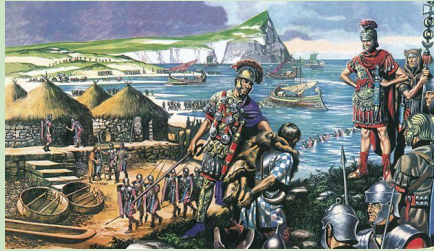

EMPEROR

A SOVEREIGN RULER OF AN EMPIRE .

BOUDICCA

THE LEADER OF ICENI TRIBE, A CELTIC TRIBE FROM THE EAST OF ENGLAND .

ARTEFACTS

AN OBJECT MADE BY A HUMAN BEING, TYPICALLY ONE OF CULTURAL OR HISTORICAL INTEREST .
