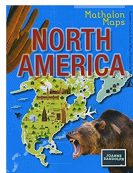
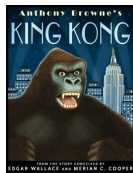


### English

*Writing-* Our vehicle text will be King Kong by Anthony Browne. We will be using a range of figurative language in narratives to describe settings, characters and atmosphere. We'll integrate dialogue to convey characters. We'll use further organisational and presentational devices to structure text and to guide the reader.

### Spelling:

In spelling, we will be exploring words with silent letters such as b,k, or g and words containing the letter string 'ough'. We'll review the use of apostrophes for contractions. Our weekly spelling tests will link to these spelling objectives.



### Reading

Reading lessons take place each day. We will focus on nonfiction texts this half term; our first text will be North America by Mathalon Maps. Reading and share with me books are sent home weekly. We have a class poem of the week that will be sent home and 'Going for Gold' reading challenges to complete. Please continue to read 4 times per week at home and record in diaries.

### Science

We will be looking at Earth and space. We will name the eight planets in order and learn the sun is a star at the centre of our solar system. We will learn that planets orbit the sun and it takes 365 ¼ days for the Earth to orbit the sun. We will make models and conduct experiments to support our learning.

### History-Monarchy

We will be learning about significant historical events, people and places. We will be learning about the impact of Queen Victoria's reign and identifying the key events during this time. We'll focus on recognising the legacy the Victorian Era imprinted on our society and what is still in place today.

## Oak Class Summer Term 2023

### PE

Oak class will have PE twice a week, on Monday with Mr Gibbons and Friday with Miss Taylor and Mr Scott. In our lessons we will learn to develop our athletics skills. Later in the term, we'll perfect our golfing techniques focussing on posture, swing and correct club handling in tri-golf. Swimming will also take place each Tuesday.

### PSHE

In PSHE we will be learning about ourselves in the wider world. We will be focusing on self organisation, specifically talking about time management, how to work collaboratively in a team and how we can demonstrate leadership skills, valuing and respecting diversity and understanding our own values and beliefs.

### RE

In RE, we will be focusing on Judaism and Christianity. We will make links between Jewish beliefs and the Torah, the impact of their beliefs and values and the diversity of religious practices and lifestyles. We will also learn about what Christians mean by "God is Trinity" and places like Taizé where Christians from different backgrounds might come together to worship

### Modern Foreign Languages

In French lessons, we will be learning how to describe the seasons and weather. Then we'll learn how to say what we are wearing and what we'd wear to the beach. We'll revisit the feminine and masculine rules of nouns.

### Maths

In this unit, we will build on children's knowledge of multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000 and apply this to converting measures and word problems. This unit also teaches children the properties of shapes and angles. Within this unit, children will learn to draw and measure angles at a point, full turn and on a straight line.

### Art and DT

In Art, we will be learning how to construct collages using a variety of media whilst expanding our knowledge of techniques and style. We will be studying the artist Njideka Ankwunyili Crosby. In DT, we will use mechanical systems (CAM) to produce a product that can be programmed to move, change direction and complete a specific task. We will work with Tarporley High School to use CAM and produce our own mechanical products.

### Music

In music the children will be able to play melodies on tuned percussion/instruments and will understand how to play chords. The children will be learning about "Folk" music and will be able to listen and appreciate this genre.

### Computing

In computing we will be learning about 3D modelling and concept maps. We will be using 2Focus and MAKE to design and print. We will also create a concept map and be able to discuss how they can be used to retell stories and present information.
